## Did you know?

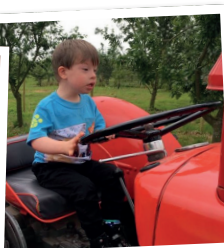
- > We have **supported 120** families since Downright Special was founded 12 years ago.
